Graduate Research Assistantship in Missouri String Project



The MU School of Music offers graduate assistantships to qualified master of music and doctoral students. The **Missouri String Project** research assistantship is a quarter-time appointment (**10hrs per week**) with an anticipated stipend of **\$8,910 (Masters) - \$9,800 (Doctoral)**. This amount is paid to students over the nine months of the academic year.

In addition, tuition for coursework required for the degree is waived during the appointment period. This waiver covers both Missouri residents and non-residents at all levels. The latest information on tuition and fees may be found at <https://cashiers.missouri.edu>.

Quarter-time assistantships also come with a **50% allowance for health insurance**.

Applicants may qualify for assistantships in other areas as well. Please email the School of Music (music@missouri.edu) for available assistantships.

Teaching in small group classes, giving private lessons, and working with full orchestra. Administrative support for the Missouri String Project; Communicating with students and parents.
