Graduate Teaching Assistantship in Musicology

The MU School of Music offers graduate assistantships to qualified master of music students. The **Musicology** teaching assistantship is a quarter-time appointment (**10hrs per week**) with an anticipated stipend of **\$8,910**. This amount is paid to students over the nine months of the academic year.

In addition, tuition for coursework required for the degree is waived during the appointment period. This waiver covers both Missouri residents and non-residents at all levels. The latest information on tuition and fees may be found at <https://cashiers.missouri.edu>.

Quarter-time assistantships also come with a **50% allowance for health insurance**.

Assisting music history faculty in the preparation of courses, serving as the teaching assistant for a large-enrollment course for non-majors, or teaching courses for non-music majors.
