Graduate Research Assistantship with the Higday Community Outreach Program



The MU School of Music offers graduate assistantships to qualified master of music and doctoral students. The **Higday Community Outreach Program** research assistantship is a quarter-time appointment (**10hrs per week**) with an anticipated stipend of **\$8,910 (Masters) - \$9,800 (Doctoral)**. This amount is paid to students over the nine months of the academic year.

In addition, tuition for coursework required for the degree is waived during the appointment period. This waiver covers both Missouri residents and non-residents at all levels. The latest information on tuition and fees may be found at <https://cashiers.missouri.edu/>.

Quarter-time assistantships also come with a **50% allowance for health insurance**.

Applicants may qualify for assistantships in other areas as well. Please email the School of Music (music@missouri.edu) for available assistantships.

Duties may include

Administering the Higday outreach program by recruiting volunteers and organizing several performances in the community each semester. Emailing K-12 music educators, local organizations, MU students, and faculty to organize events. Overseeing the hire-a-musician program and assisting as needed with Community Music @ Mizzou related tasks.
