Graduate Teaching Assistantship in Orchestral Conducting

he MU School of Music offers a number of graduate assistantships to qualified master and doctoral students. The **Orchestral Conducting** teaching assistantship is a quarter-time appointment (**10hrs per week)** with an anticipated stipend of **\$8,910.** This amount is paid to students over the nine months of the academic year.
