Graduate Research Assistantship in **Budds Center for American Music Studies**



The MU School of Music offers graduate assistantships to qualified master of music students with research interest in music of the USA and Missouri. The **Budds Center** graduate assistantship is a quarter-time appointment (**10hrs per week**) with an anticipated stipend of **\$9,089**. This amount is paid to students over the nine months of the academic year.

In addition, tuition for coursework required for the degree is waived during the appointment period. This waiver covers both Missouri residents and non-residents at all levels. The latest information on tuition and fees may be found at <https://cashiers.missouri.edu>.

Quarter-time assistantships also come with a **50% allowance for health insurance**.
