

Graduate Teaching Assistantship in Music Education



he MU School of Music offers graduate assistantships to qualified master of music and doctoral students. The Music Education teaching assistantship is a quarter-time to half-time appointment (10-20hrs per week) with an anticipated stipend of \$9,089 - \$18,177 (Masters) or \$9,996 - \$19,992 (Doctoral). This amount is paid to students over the nine months of the academic year.

In addition, tuition for coursework required for the degree is waived during the appointment period. This waiver covers both Missouri residents and non-residents at all levels. The latest information on tuition and fees may be found at https://cashiers.missouri.edu/cost/.

Half-time assistantships also come with full health insurance coverage and quarter-time assistantships come with a 50% allowance for health insurance.

Applicants may qualify for assistantships in other areas as well. Please email the School of Music (<u>music@missouri.edu</u>) for available assistantships.

Duties may include

Teaching music skills or methods courses for elementary and early childhood education majors, teaching beginning folk guitar class, and assisting faculty in the music education area.
