

Graduate Teaching Assistantship in Musicology



he MU School of Music offers graduate assistantships to qualified master's students in music. The Musicology teaching assistantship is a quarter-time to half-time appointment (10-20hrs per week) with an anticipated stipend of \$9,089-\$18,177.

In addition, tuition for coursework required for the degree is waived during the appointment period. This waiver covers both Missouri residents and non-residents at all levels. The latest information on tuition and fees may be found at https://cashiers.missouri.edu.

Half-time assistantships also come with full health insurance coverage, and 0.25 FTE appointments come with a 50% allowance for health insurance.

Applicants may qualify for assistantships in other areas as well. Please email the School of Music (<u>music@missouri.edu</u>) for available assistantships.

Duties may include

Assisting musicology faculty in the administration of courses as well as serving as the teaching assistant for large-enrollment courses for non-majors and smaller enrollment courses for majors, e.g., Music and Culture for freshman and the two-semester History of Western Music.
