Graduate Teaching Assistantship in Piano



The MU School of Music offers graduate assistantships to qualified master of music and doctoral students. **Piano** teaching assistantships are quarter-time appointments (**10hrs per week**) with anticipated stipends of **\$9,089**. This amount is paid to students over the nine months of the academic year.

In addition, tuition for coursework required for the degree is waived during the appointment period. This waiver covers both Missouri residents and non-residents at all levels. The latest information on tuition and fees may be found at <https://cashiers.missouri.edu>.

Quarter-time assistantships also come with a **50% allowance for health insurance**.

Applicants may qualify for assistantships in other areas as well. Please email the School of Music (music@missouri.edu) for available assistantships.

Teaching music majors in group piano, teaching majors and non-majors in individual applied lessons, studio accompanying, choral and opera accompanying, assisting in maintaining the pedagogy library.
