Concert Bands and Orchestra – Information for new and returning woodwind, brass, percussion, and string students

All new and returning wind and percussion students are required to audition for ensemble placement at the beginning of the spring semester. Non-music majors interested in joining University Band will not need to audition.

String placements from Fall 2025 will remain the same for Spring 2026. If you are not currently a member of the University Symphony Orchestra and would like to join, please contact Dr. John McKeever (<u>john.mckeever@missouri.edu</u>) to set up an audition time.

Tubas and euphoniums will not be re-auditioning for Spring 2026. Tubas/Euphoniums interested in playing in a concert ensemble but who did not play in one in Fall 2025, should contact Dr. Angelo Manzo (manzoan@missouri.edu) to arrange an individual audition.

Jazz Ensembles - Information for NEW big band members and all combo members

Current members of jazz ensembles will not need to re-audition for Spring 2026. Auditions for combos will include improvisation on 1-2 tunes of the student's choice. Students should select tunes that they are comfortable with and demonstrate their abilities.

Auditions will take place **Tuesday, January 20, 2026, 4:00-6:00 PM** in Sinquefield Music Center Room 306. The audition process will take approximately 10 minutes. Audition sign-ups are available at https://www.signupgenius.com/go/70A0B4BAFA823A0FF2-60548194-jazz

Rosters will be posted by Wednesday, January 21 at 10 AM. Adjustments to registration will need to be made immediately after audition results are posted. Rehearsals will begin Wednesday, January 21 as scheduled.

Audition Requirements

Instrumentalists:

- Sight-reading (big band only)
- Improvisation (required for combo, optional for big band)
- Players select a tune of their choice. Performers newer to improvisation are encouraged to improvise over a blues. More advanced improvisers are encouraged to select a more challenging tune.
- Prepared Etude (optional for big band available at <u>music.missouri.edu/ensemble/jazz-ensembles</u>. Prepared etudes
 can be used to help determine chair and/or band placement. They are encouraged but not a required part of the
 audition process.

Drummers:

- Various grooves at a variety of tempos (swing, shuffle, bossa nova, funk, ballad with brushes, etc.)
- Sight-reading (big band only)
- Soloing (optional if demonstrating solo ability, be prepared to solo over the form of a song, as well as trade 4 or 8 bar phrases).

Vocalists:

- Two pieces, memorized (one medium-up tempo swing, 32 bars maximum; one ballad, 16 bars maximum)
- Improvisation is optional
- If you have selected a tune that falls outside the Great American Songbook, please have your own accompaniment prepared.
