Dear Band Director:

The University of Missouri School of Music is pleased to announce the Tenth Annual *MU All-Juniors Honor Band*! This event will take place on the Columbia campus, February 20–21, 2022, and will provide 11th-grade band students the opportunity to experience the collegiate concert band environment through interaction with MU School of Music faculty and students. Juniors chosen for this Honor Band will receive instruction from both MU band and applied faculty members. The event will culminate in a joint concert with the MU Wind Ensemble at the historic Missouri Theatre in downtown Columbia. The \$50 participation fee covers the cost for a commemorative t-shirt and meals while on campus. All selected students are expected to provide their own transportation to and from Columbia for the event. Also, unlike previous years, selected students will need to make their own arrangements for housing the night of February 20. A list of hotels in the area is provided at the end of this letter.

Juniors who earned a position in an MMEA All-District Honor Band will receive automatic acceptance into the *MU All-Juniors Honor Band*. Furthermore, those who participated as sophomores in the 2021 All-State Band or are current juniors who will perform in the 2022 All-State Band (or were Honorable Mention) will receive automatic acceptance and *will have their participation fee waived*. For 2022, due to the pandemic, we have also extended automatic acceptance and a fee waiver to anyone who was a freshman or junior in the 2021 All-State Band. Please note, however, that there is a limit to the number of instrumentalists in each section that can be accepted. **Please distribute the enclosed letters to the students from your band that we have identified as meeting the above criteria. If these students would like to participate in the** *MU All-Juniors Honor Band***, you may nominate them via the link below, or they may nominate themselves. You are also encouraged to nominate additional qualified 11th-grade band members for this event.**

Nominations should be made by Friday, December 3, 2021. MU band faculty will then make final selections and you will be notified of your students' acceptance status by December 17th.
