# WHAT TO BRING

- All wind players must provide their own instrument, mouthpiece, reeds, etc. Percussionists should ONLY bring sticks and mallets (identifiably marked)—NO instruments. All percussion instruments will be provided by MU. Have extra reeds, valve/slide oil, mutes, sticks, and mallets on hand! The MU School of Music does not sell supplies.
  - Trumpet and Trombone players: You will need to bring straight mutes!
  - The use of masks, bell covers, and other COVID mitigation tools is strongly encouraged, though not required. You will need to plan to bring these items with you; MU will not supply them.
- Upon arriving to campus, you will receive the *MU All-Juniors Honor Band* T-shirt. This T-shirt, along with your own black dress pants, black socks, and black dress shoes, will be the attire **for all participants** in the Monday evening concert. Don't forget to pack these important items!
- Dress for the weather! You will be walking between buildings for rehearsals, masterclasses, and meals. Check the local weather before departing for Mizzou and be sure you have appropriate clothing (e.g., shoes, coats, hats).
- Dinner on Sunday evening, as well as lunch and dinner on Monday, will be provided. You will be responsible for breakfast Monday morning before rehearsal. You may also want to bring extra money for snacks.

#### AUDITIONS

• Your audition on Sunday will consist of (1) selected major scales (up to three flats and three sharps) and (2) a sight-reading excerpt. Each of these materials will be chosen by the MU faculty member administrating the audition.

### HOUSING AND TRANSPORTATION

- You are responsible for securing and funding your own lodging, including transportation to and from campus for all rehearsals and the concert. There are many hotel options in Columbia within walking or driving distance to campus and the Missouri Theatre.
- Garage and street parking is free on Sunday, so a parking permit is not required for February 20. Students, band directors, and parents who will need on-campus parking during the day on Monday, February 17, should register for a virtual parking permit for Hitt Street Garage by February 10, 2022. The cost of the permit is paid by the MU School of Music; however, individuals will be responsible for any fines received due to failure to register.

#### **FINAL CONCERT**

- Friends, family, and band directors are welcome to attend the final concert. Tickets are \$5.00 and are available for purchase at the door. For those unable to attend, the concert will be available to live stream on the School of Music's <u>YouTube</u> channel.
- For those attending the Monday evening concert, parking in campus/city garages is free after 6 PM. Meters for street parking are active until 7 PM and will accept coins or payment via the ParkMobile App (available on Apple and Android devices).

#### **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

• In case of inclement weather, notification of any schedule changes will be sent via the email address listed on your registration form. Updates will also be posted at <u>music.missouri.edu/all-juniors-honor-band</u>. Please note that registration fee refunds will only be given if the event is canceled due to inclement weather.

# **MU Campus Map and Parking Information**

- Free parking for registration on Sunday is available in the Hitt Street Garage (Levels 1-3), and on any of the streets surrounding the Missouri Theatre (meters do not run on Sunday).
- If you <u>registered your vehicle</u> for on-campus parking, you may park your car on Levels 1-3 in Hitt Street Garage on Sunday AND Monday. Campus parking permits are "virtual" so you will not receive a physical or electronic permit.
- Parking for the concert on Monday is available in Hitt Street Garage (Levels 1-3) for free after 6
  PM, or on the streets surrounding the Missouri Theatre (metered until 7 PM). Meters for street
  parking will accept coins or payment via the ParkMobile App (available on Apple and Android
  devices).
