Mizzou Saxophone Ensemble

The Mizzou Saxophone Ensemble is comprised of saxophone students of Professor Leo Saguiguit, as well as additional members from the University community. Performers from various disciplines across campus are represented and include aspiring music professionals as well as avocational players who wish to continue their musical development. The ensemble performs a wide variety of musical styles and has premiered works at the Biennial Conferences of the North American Saxophone Alliance at the University of Illinois and the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music.

Dr. Craig Young, electronic wind instrument (EWI) soloist

Dr. Craig Young recently left his position as Director of Bands and Instructor of Saxophone at Mississippi College after 23 years. In addition to his responsibilities at Mississippi College, he founded and served as Music Director of the Mississippi Wind Symphony, a professional-level ensemble formed in 2001, for 20 years. He continues to regularly perform on the saxophone and wind controller in classical, Broadway musical, and jazz venues. He has been a featured soloist with the Mississippi Symphony and Metropolitan Orchestras, recorded for Delos, performed as a member of the Black Swamp Saxophone Quartet, and was honored by being invited to compete at the 1st International Adolphe Sax Competition in Dinant, Belgium. Dr. Young received his bachelor's degree from Bowling Green State University and both a master's degree and a Ph.D. from The Ohio State University and has visited 47 states and several countries through his varied musical activities. His wife, Joann, heads up the Microbiology division at IDEXX, and they have two grown children.
