**Logan King** (b. 2002) is a senior music education major at the University of Missouri. As a saxophonist in the School of Music, Logan has played with ensembles such as the Wind Ensemble, Concert Jazz Band, Saxophone Ensemble, and multiple saxophone quartets. Logan has also performed with the Columbia Jazz Orchestra, Hitt Street Harmony, and several other ensembles within the School of Music and Columbia community. Logan participated in the Missouri Music Teachers Association Competition as a soloist and a member of Sax Evasion, a saxophone quartet, throughout college. In 2022, Logan received runner-up in the upper woodwinds category at Southeast Missouri State University. In both 2022 and 2023, Sax Evasion took first place in the woodwind ensemble category. Other honors Logan has received is the 2022 William and Stella Pommer Award, Pi Kappa Lambda Certificate of Honor (2022 & 2023), Jack J. Isgur Foundation Scholarship (2022 & 2023) and has been on the Dean's List every semester of college to this point.

Throughout his time at Mizzou, Logan has been involved in multiple aspects of the School of Music and Columbia community. Logan has served as Secretary for the collegiate chapter of National Association of Music Education at the University of Missouri. He has also served as Treasurer and is the current President of the Zeta chapter of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. During his time in these positions, Logan has been able to serve on the Student Advisory Council (SAC) under the leadership of Dr. Rawlings.

Throughout his time at Mizzou, Logan has also received several teaching experiences in the Columbia community. Logan has worked with multiple of the middle schools and high schools in the Columbia Public School District as a part of his field experiences and as a volunteer helper. He is also the current saxophone instructor for the Community Music Program. Logan has had the distinct pleasure of being a guest conductor with the Mizzou Saxophone Ensemble in both the spring and fall semesters of 2023. As a part of his conducting courses at Mizzou, Logan led the University Philharmonic Orchestra, Wind Ensemble, and University Band through rehearsals and sight-reading.

This coming spring, Logan will be student teaching in the Kansas City area and applying for jobs in the music education field for the 2023-2024 school year.
