UPDATED 78th Marching Mizzou Band Day
September 13, 2025

7:45 AM - High School Band and Individual Participant arrival to Marching Mizzou Practice Field area. Meet your Band Day Guide who will accompany you throughout the day.

Please reference the Band Day Bus Map for Full Bands for traffic flow. All personal cars will need to find alternate parking either in a campus garage or other location. Upon arrival, you will receive tickets for what was requested on your Band Day application. Band Day participants will be seated in section 124 and 125 on the west side of the stadium.

8:15 AM - Band Day Rehearsal at Marching Mizzou Practice Field

9:15 PM - Band Day Rehearsal Ends. Remain for Informal "Meet and Greet" with our members. Parents and Directors are encouraged to visit with our Admissions Coordinator during this time.

9:45 PM – Meet and Greet Ends

Break – This is an ideal time to take a snack and water break and find a shady spot to relax. The snack must be consumed before entering Memorial Stadium. One sealed water bottle per person may be taken into the stadium.

11:00 AM (or prior) - High School Bands walk to the stadium with their Band Guide for seating and to watch Marching Mizzou perform Pre-Game. Please allow plenty of time to move to the west side of the stadium and navigate crowds.

11:10 AM - Marching Mizzou marches to the Stadium

All bands will enter through Gate 5W (southwest side of Memorial Stadium). Each person will need a ticket to enter the stadium. Bands are not permitted to troop to the stadium; traffic will not be stopped on surrounding roads. Students are not permitted to play on the concourse level or in the stands at any point during the game.

12:00 PM - Kickoff vs. Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns. Go Tigers!

1:30 PM - Approximate Halftime Performance with High School Bands

To avoid traffic congestion following the game, full bands are encouraged to depart after halftime. Note that due to Southeastern Conference regulations, no one is permitted to re-enter the stadium during the course of a game. If full bands choose to depart before the end of the game, buses can pick up students near the intersection of Mick Deaver and Champions Drive or in the gravel area near Lot G off Champions Drive, so as long as traffic is not obstructed.
