What is the Missouri String Project?

- The Missouri String Project (MSP) is a youth music program hosted by the University of Missouri-Columbia. We help students ages 8 and up build musicianship, performance skills, and confidence while learning to play a stringed instrument!

When and where does MSP meet?

- MSP students attend group lessons **two times per week**. Families can choose from one of two schedule options in the enrollment application:
 1. Monday, 4:10-5:00 PM **and** Friday, 5:10-6:00 PM
 2. Wednesday, 4:10-5:00 PM **and** Friday, 5:10-6:00 PM
- Monday/Wednesday classes are held in the Fine Arts Building and Friday classes are held in the Sinquefeld Music Center.
Fall 2026 classes begin the week of September 14.

What are the costs?

- \$250 per semester, **due September 11**—more affordable than similar programs. **Scholarships are available on a first-come basis! (info available in the application)**
- For success in MSP, students must have all necessary supplies (including an instrument!). **Our partner, Top Notch Violins, will be at both instrument try-out events to facilitate the instrument rental process!**
